THE CNMV TO MOVE ITS BARCELONA HEADQUARTERS TO THE CNMC BUILDING, LOCATED IN THE 22@ TECHNOLOGY DISTRICT

The Board of the CNMV, which held a meeting today in Barcelona, and which among other resolutions, authorised the takeover bids for DIA and Telepizza, also decided to move its Barcelona office, which is currently located at Paseo de Gracia 19, to calle Bolivia, in the 22@ district, specifically to the building in Barcelona where the CNMC (Spain's National Commission on Markets and Competition) already has its headquarters.

Among the reasons for the move are the excellent facilities and spaces in the building, which the CNMV intends to take advantage of, in particular, for meetings related to the international organisations of which it forms part (such as the European Securities and Markets Authority, ESMA, and the International Organisation of Securities Commissions, IOSCO). The move is expected to be effectively carried out in 2019.
