The prize, which is endowed with 15,000 euros, aims to reward journalistic works that have stood out for promoting the integrity and transparency of the market and investor protection, as well as for their contribution to financial education. These are some of the values that guide the CNMV's activity and that it must continue to promote and foster.

The prize may be awarded to any article, report or journalistic work published in the Spanish media or distributed through any format or channel between 1 January and 31 December 2025, in any of Spain's official languages.
