

## THE CNMV ANNOUNCES NEW PUBLIC RECRUITMENT PROCESS WITH 32 PERMANENT, QUALITY POSITIONS

- Eight positions are reserved for people with disabilities

The Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) has announced a public recruitment process for the appointment of 32 permanent technical and administrative positions. The specialisation range of said positions is broad:

- Sixteen technical positions assigned to supervisory functions across various directorates and departments, as well as within the Studies and Statistics Area. One of these positions is specifically allocated to the CNMV Branch in Bilbao
- Within the Technology and Digital Innovation Area, the recruitment includes four positions in Information Systems Development, two infrastructure-related positions, one Technological Risk Supervision Specialist, and one Digital Transformation Specialist
- Seven Administrative positions
- One position in Procurement and Purchasing

This year's recruitment initiative continues the trend observed in recent years towards strengthening the appointment of specialists in technology-related positions, alongside more traditional financial and legal profiles.

Candidates applying for technical positions must hold a university degree (Licentiate, Architect, Engineer, or Bachelor's degree).

A total of eight positions are reserved for people with disabilities, covering a variety of profiles, including supervision, studies and statistics, development, and administrative functions.

The selection process consists of two stages:

- An initial competitive examination stage, comprising four tests: a multiple-choice test, an English language test, a written test, and an oral examination
- A subsequent tendering stage for candidates who successfully pass the examination stage
