



THE CNMV PUBLISHES PRACTICAL GUIDE ON THE EUROPEAN SINGLE ACCESS POINT (ESAP) FOR REPORTING ENTITIES

16 June 2026

- The ESAP is a platform that will provide centralised access to key information relating to financial services and capital markets in the EU
- It will be phased in from 10 July 2026, starting with short selling, prospectuses and transparency disclosures
- Information will be submitted to the CNMV through the existing channels available on its Virtual Office

The Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) has today published a [Practical Guide on the European Single Access Point](#) (ESAP)¹, the platform that will provide centralised access to publicly available information relevant to financial services and capital markets in the EU.

Its purpose is to improve data transparency, clarity and standardisation by offering access to supervisory authorities, investors, and public institutions. It also aims to increase firms' visibility and funding opportunities, as well as facilitate informed decision-making.

The ESAP will be implemented in a staggered manner. Phase 1 will commence on 10 July 2026 and will cover the data flows provided for in the Transparency Directive, the Prospectus Regulation and the Short Selling Regulation. The information on the ESAP is expected to become accessible from July 2027.

Entities required to disclose their information pursuant to the aforementioned regulations must also submit it to the designated collection bodies so that it can be consulted on the ESAP. The CNMV will act as the collection body for Phase 1 data flows and will gather the information, including the necessary metadata, through the existing applicable channels, available on its Virtual Office.

The guide will be regularly updated to incorporate information relating to the subsequent stages of the project.
