

## JURY'S DECISION ON THE 2020 ANTONIO MORENO ESPEJO JOURNALISM AWARD

- Miguel A. García Vega has been awarded the prize for the work “La economía mutará tras el virus” (The economy will mutate after the virus), published in the newspaper *El País* in April 2020

The Jury of the 2020 Antonio Moreno Espejo Journalism Award has decided to give the award in its fourth edition to the following article: “La economía mutará tras el virus”, by Miguel A. García Vega, published in the newspaper *El País*.

The Jury has based its decision on the quality of the article, the ability to anticipate trends and their impact on the economy and financial markets (it was published in April 2020), as well as the in-depth way in which it analyses the potential effect that the pandemic could have on the economy worldwide, and its impact on habits and behaviour, which could help investors to form an opinion on the financial markets affected by this situation.

Furthermore, it has highlighted the extent of the sources consulted and the correct selection of the topics considered in a context that is so unpredictable and unknown to date.

117 articles published in 28 different media were entered into or selected on a preliminary basis for this year's call.

The CNMV created this award in memory of Antonio Moreno Espejo, who was a member of the institution's staff from its inception in the late eighties until his death, when he was the director of the Institution Authorisation and Registration Department, in January 2017. The award carries a cash price of 15,000 euros.
