



Traffic Note December 2010

Vueling closed 2010 with over 11 million passengers carried, an annual record since the founding of the company

The figure represents an increase of 35% year on year

The airline also increased its load factor by 1.9 in the last quarter of the year.

Barcelona, 11th January 2011. – Vueling, the new generation airline, carried 11,036,183 passengers in the January-December 2010 period, which implies a 35% increase with respect to the same period last year.

New routes for summer 2011

For 2011 summer season, Vueling has launched a wide range of new routes which represents an increase of 8% in the total capacity of the company. In April 2011, the airline will also open two new international bases, Amsterdam and Toulouse, thus contributing to its international growth strategy. Vueling will offer next summer (March-October) a total of 10.5 million seats compared to 9.8 million offered in the same period of 2010. Vueling's forecast for 2011 is to maintain the growth path taken since 2010.
