

Traffic Note October 2010

Vueling carried 976,942 passengers in October, an increase of 15.7% year on year

The airline has also increased its load factor by 2.0 percentage points in October

Barcelona, 9th November 2010. – Vueling, the new generation airline, carried 976,942 passengers in October which represents an increase of 15.7% on the same period in 2009.

ASK (available seat-kilometer): number of seats flown multiplied by the number of miles flown

RPK (passenger-kilometers transported): number of passengers carried multiplied by the number of miles flown

Wide range of schedules on the main business routes

This increase in passengers is due to the focus on business passengers, for whom Vueling has increased the number of daily frequencies. Currently, 75% of Vueling flights operate in routes where Vueling offers two or more daily frequencies, including 13 frequencies between Barcelona and Madrid and 6 frequencies in flights connecting Barcelona with Paris and Seville. Frequencies in business routes have increased by 13% compared to the same period of 2009, offering more than 60 new weekly frequencies in business routes.
