

May 2012 traffic

Vueling increases the number of passengers carried in May by 15%

The company increases its load factor by 1.5 points year-on-year, reaching a 74.3% load factor

Barcelona, 11th June 2012. – Vueling, the new generation airline, has carried 1,274,047 passengers in May 2012. This represents a 14.8% increase compared to May 2011. The company has reached a load factor of 74.3%, 1.5 points higher than last year.
