

**SIEMENS GAMESA RENEWABLE ENERGY, S.A.  
SIGNIFICANT EVENT**

**As per section 17 of the Regulation (EU) No. 596/2014, on market abuse and section 228 of the restated text of the Securities Market Law approved by the Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October (*texto refundido de la Ley del Mercado de Valores aprobado por el Real Decreto Legislativo 4/2015, de 23 de octubre*) and related provisions, the Company announces the following statement:**

An affiliate of Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy, S.A. (formerly known as Gamesa Corporación Tecnológica, S.A.) has signed contracts with an affiliate of DONG Energy for the supply and for the service and maintenance of 94 wind turbines for a total power of 752 MW in the Netherlands. These contracts are still subject to notice of effectiveness by DONG.

The agreements encompass the supply of 94 units of SWT 8 MW turbines at the Borssele 1 and 2 offshore wind power plants being developed in Dutch waters, which are scheduled for commissioning in 2020, and the maintenance of the turbines. The wind farm will be located 22km from the coast of the Dutch province of Zeeland with a water depth of 14-38m and will cover an area of 128.3km<sup>2</sup>.
