

**SIEMENS GAMESA RENEWABLE ENERGY, S.A.
SIGNIFICANT EVENT**

As per section 17 of the Regulation (EU) No. 596/2014, on market abuse and section 227 of the restated text of the Securities Market Law and related provisions, the Company announces the following statement:

Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy, S.A., through one of its subsidiaries, has been selected by Dominion Energy as the preferred wind turbine generator supplier for the Dominion Energy Virginia Offshore Wind (DEVOW) project, located off the coast of Virginia (U.S.), with a capacity of 2,640 MW and including also a long-term service and maintenance agreement.

The delivery is subject to execution of final project contracts, to project approvals and to Dominion Energy's final investment decision. The offshore installations are expected to be completed by end of 2026.
