

Reaches its 25-millionth passenger

Vueling doubles its November passenger volume

Seat load factor increased by 2.3 percentage points

Barcelona, December 11th, 2009. – Vueling, the new-generation airline, carried 743,888 passengers in November, more than twice the amount carried during the same period one year earlier. Seat-load factor increased by 2.3 percentage points—to 67.6%.

Vueling also doubled the number of flights (from 2,999 to 6,131, year on year) and planes on its fleet, from 16 to 35.

Over 25 million passengers

Vueling reached the 25-million passenger mark in November, after slightly over 5 years of operations. Passenger volumes greatly increased during 2009 thanks to its merger with Clickair: as recently as in September 2008, Vueling had reached its 15-millionth passenger.
