

CMVM issues warning to investors concerning EG Investment Group and XUEX

The CMVM issues a warning for investors concerning EG Investment Group (<https://a-egig.vip>) and XUEX (<https://xuexv.com/>), which are not authorised to carry out any type of financial intermediation activity in Portugal, under Article 295 of the Portuguese Securities Code, or any other subject to the supervision of the CMVM.

The CMVM clarifies that these entities are not legally qualified to carry out advertising or prospecting for clients to sign financial intermediation contracts.

To ensure that a certain entity that provides investment services in financial instruments is authorised to carry out the said activities in Portugal, one should consult the list of authorised entities to provide financial services in Portugal via the [link](#).
