

**SIEMENS GAMESA RENEWABLE ENERGY, S.A.  
SIGNIFICANT EVENT**

**As per section 17 of the Regulation (EU) No. 596/2014, on market abuse and section 228 of the restated text of the Securities Market Law approved by the Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October (*texto refundido de la Ley del Mercado de Valores aprobado por el Real Decreto Legislativo 4/2015, de 23 de octubre*) and related provisions, the Company announces the following statement:**

Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy, S.A. ("Siemens Gamesa" or the "Company") through its Danish subsidiary Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy A/S, has signed contracts with Vattenfall Vindkraft Vesterhav Syd P/S and Vattenfall Vindkraft Vesterhav Nord P/S (subsidiaries of Vattenfall AB) for the supply and for the service and maintenance of a total of 41 wind turbines to be located nearshore at the west coast of Denmark in the North Sea with a combined capacity of approximately 350 MW.

The agreements encompass the supply and installation of 41 turbines of SG 8.0-167 DD offshore, to be installed in 2020 and to be ready for commissioning for the end of that same year, and for the service and maintenance of the turbines.
