Financial Soultions and Commodore Asset

The Banking, Finance and Insurance Commission (CBFA) warns the public against the activities of Financial Soultions (www.financialsoultions.com) and Commodore Asset (www.commodoreasset.com), which are contacting Belgian investors with a view to offering investment services. There seems to be some link between those two companies.

Financial Soultions claims to be a firm with registered office at NY 1006, 165 Broadway New York, Suite 3625. It does not have the authorization in Belgium necessary to offer investment services in or from Belgium.

Commodore Asset claims to be a firm with registered office in Ohio, US. It does not have the authorization in Belgium necessary to offer investment services in or from Belgium.

The CBFA thus advises the public against responding to any offers of investment services made in the name of Financial Soultions or Commodore Asset and against transferring money to any account number they might mention.
