## **Lufthansa sells Amadeus Shares**

**Book profit of around 290 million euros achieved**

Deutsche Lufthansa AG has today placed a 13.2 percent stake in Amadeus Global Travel Distribution S.A. via the Madrid Stock Exchange. Within one hour, in an accelerated bookbuilding offering, 78 million Class A Shares were sold at a price of 5.05 euros to institutional investors. Accordingly, Lufthansa's stake in Amadeus will decline from 18.3 percent to 5.1 percent.

Lufthansa will receive a sum of 394 million euros from this transaction. As a result, the company will realize a book profit of around 290 million euros in the current financial year.

Following the already completed sales of GlobeGround and DHL, Lufthansa is thus steadily pursuing its active portfolio management. "The decision is logical, strategic and, in view of the present market climate, prudent," according to Wolfgang Mayrhuber, Chairman and CEO of Deutsche Lufthansa AG. "The regular re-examination of the portfolio is part of our Group strategy. Through the sale of this financial investment and the realized increase in value, we will further strengthen our equity basis and the Lufthansa Group."
