



## THE CNMV APPOINTS ÁNGEL BENITO MARKETS DIRECTOR-GENERAL

The Board of the Spanish National Securities Market Commission (Comisión Nacional del Mercado de Valores, CNMV), has appointed Ángel Benito as Markets Director-General.

Ángel Benito has been a commissioner of the CNMV since 2017, a position he shall continue to hold until 1 May this year, in accordance with Article 28 of the Recast Text of the Spanish Securities Market Act (TRLMV), approved by Spanish Royal Legislative Decree 4/2015, of 23 October, and Order ETD/165/2021, of 18 February, appointing a new member of the CNMV Board.

Between 2000 and 2017, Ángel Benito already held the position of Markets Director-General after previously overseeing the Primary Markets and Issues departments. He has had a long career in the securities markets field, has been a speaker in the European Union's working group on Corporate Governance, Chairman of the CNMV's Clearing and Settlement Group, and has participated in multiple working groups of ESMA and IOSCO, the European and international market supervisors, respectively, and the Financial Stability Board (FSB).

The Markets Directorate-General includes the Primary Markets, Secondary Markets, Financial and Corporate Reporting Departments and the Market Surveillance Unit.
