



THE CNMV SIGNS IOSCO'S ENHANCED MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

- This memorandum strengthens collaborative capabilities among supervisors
- It is a further step towards expanding cooperation capabilities

The CNMV's Vice-Chair, Paloma Marín, has signed the Enhanced Memorandum of Understanding (EMMoU) of the International Organisation of Securities Commissions (IOSCO), during the 50th International Conference of this multilateral organisation held in Doha (Qatar). Jean Paul Servais, Chairman of IOSCO's Board, and Rodrigo Buenaventura, IOSCO's General Secretary, attended the event.

The EMMoU is a multilateral agreement for consultation, cooperation and information exchange between securities supervisors that strengthens and amplifies collaborative capabilities of signatories.

Pursuant to this agreement, the CNMV broadens collaboration possibilities with other signatories in the following matters:

- Obtaining and exchanging audit documents,
- Requesting assistance for taking statements, and
- Assets freezing.

The CNMV's adhesion to this mechanism is a further step in strengthening international cooperation capabilities by signing an expanded and reinforced agreement with respect to the previous one.

The CNMV is the first European Union supervisor to join said agreement, reinforcing its commitment regarding international cooperation and investor protection.
