Change to the Management Committee

Beatriz Padín Santos, Director of Zara Woman and member of Inditex’s Management Committee, has announced her decision to leave the Group and, as a result, will be stepping down from her responsibilities at both Zara and Inditex.

Inditex’s executive management wishes to acknowledge Ms Padín’s exceptional contribution to the Company over more than four decades. Throughout this time, she has held a number of highly significant leadership positions – including serving as the head of Zara Woman for the past 25 years – and has played a pivotal role in the brand’s performance and evolution.

Alfredo Ferro Varela, currently Director of Zara Basic (one of the three areas that make up Zara Woman) will succeed her as head of Zara Woman. With more than 30 years’ experience within the Inditex Group, Mr Ferro has built his career across several of the Group’s retail formats and a range of business functions before assuming his current role in 2013.
