

JURY APPOINTED FOR THE SEVENTH EDITION OF THE ANTONIO MORENO ESPEJO JOURNALISM AWARD

- The winner of the prize will receive 15,000 euros

The Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) has appointed the members of the jury of the seventh edition of the Antonio Moreno Espejo Journalism Award.

This award was created by the CNMV Board as a tribute and in memory of the former director of the Authorisation and Registration Department of the Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV), position he held between 2002 and his unexpected passing in January 2017.

The prize, which is endowed with 15,000 euros, aims to reward journalistic works that have stood out for promoting the integrity and transparency of the securities market and the protection of investors' interests, as well as for their contribution to financial education, values which guide the CNMV's activity, and that this agency must promote.

Any article, story or journalistic work that has been published in the Spanish media or distributed through any format or channel between 1 January and 31 December 2023, in any of Spain's official languages, may be awarded the prize.
