Closing of the sale of a minority stake in the share capital of the owner company of the *Windanker* offshore wind farm

Pursuant to article 227 of the *Securities Markets and Investment Services Act 6/2023, of March 17 (Ley 6/2023, de 17 de marzo, de los Mercados de Valores y de los Servicios de Inversión)*, and related provisions, and further to the notice of other significant information (*comunicación de otra información relevante*) filed with this National Commission on 12 December 2024 (with official registry number 31748) we hereby inform you that, today, Iberdrola Renovables Deutschland GmbH, an indirectly wholly owned company of Iberdrola Energía Internacional, S.A. (Sociedad Unipersonal), subholding with international focus of the Iberdrola group companies outside of Spain, the United Kingdom, the United States, Brazil and Mexico, has sold to Windanker Investco B.V. (a company belonging to the group of which Kansai Electric Power Company, Incorporated is the parent company), 49% of the share capital of Windanker GmbH, owner of the *Windanker* offshore wind farm in Germany, with an installed capacity of 315 MW and currently under construction.

The closing of the aforesaid transaction, which has occurred following receipt of the requisite regulatory approvals by the purchaser, has been effected in the terms previously reported.
