The 11th edition of Financial Education Day will take place on 6 October under the slogan "Learn. Plan. Decide.". The main event will be held at the CNMV's headquarters in Barcelona. It will also be available for streaming at www.finanzasparatodos.es

The initiative, promoted by the **Financial Education Plan** launched by the **CNMV**, the **Bank of Spain**, and **the Ministry of Economy, Trade, and Business**, with the participation of collaborating entities from various sectors, aims to raise awareness among the public about the importance of acquiring knowledge in personal finance to overcome everyday situations.

This year's slogan highlights the advantages of adequate **financial planning**, built on sufficient training and information to make sound economic decisions at each stage of life, thereby securing a stable and safe future.

The event will be attended by the Chairman of the CNMV, **Carlos San Basilio**, the Deputy Governor of the Bank of Spain, **Soledad Núñez**, the Director-General of the Treasury and Financial Policy, **Carla Díaz**, and other representatives from the participating institutions.

Spanish canoeist **Saúl Craviotto**, two-time Olympic champion, four-time world champion, and three-time European champion, will speak at the event, discussing the importance of financial planning throughout his career.

The Finance for All Awards will also be presented. In this edition, the award for best career goes to the Association of Collective Investment Institutions and Pension Funds





(INVERCO) for its strong commitment to financial education. The award for **best initiative** goes to **BANKIDU**, a project founded by two young entrepreneurs aimed at introducing financial education to children as young as three.

During the event, the final of the **School Financial Education Competition** will also take place, with this year introducing a new cadet category. The finalists in the cadet category are **Colegio Entreolivos** in Dos Hermanas, Seville, and **IES José Arencibia Gil** in Telde, Las Palmas. In the youth category, the finalists are two schools in Madrid: **Colegio El Prado** and **Colegio Alemán**.
