Further to the other relevant information disclosure No. 3094 published on 18 February 2026, the Company announces that the Spanish Government's Council of Ministers today approved the Third Airport Regulation Document (DORA), which will be in force for the next five years (2027-2031).

The approval of the DORA fulfils the statutory requirement set out in Law 18/2014 of 15 October approving urgent measures for growth, competitiveness and efficiency (Law 18/2014) and sets the parameters that Aena must follow in managing its Spanish airport network in relation to (i) investments to be made; (ii) the setting of charges; (iii) the WACC; and (iv) capacity and quality requirements.

Aena will comment as appropriate on the content of the DORA once it has been communicated by the competent authority.
