

THE CNMV HOSTS THE NINTH EDITION OF THE ANTONIO MORENO ESPEJO JOURNALISM AWARD

- The award is a tribute to the vital and professional career of Antonio Moreno Espejo, former Director of the CNMV Institution Authorisation and Registration Department for 15 years
- The winner of the prize will receive 15,000 euros.

The Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) announces the ninth edition of the <u>Antonio Moreno Espejo Journalism Award</u> for 2025.

The award recognises all those journalistic works that have stood out over the year for promoting integrity and transparency in the securities market, as well as the safeguarding of interests and investor protection, which are values that guide the CNMV's activity and that the Commission must foster. The prize consists of 15,000 euros and is awarded in a single category.

Antonio Moreno Espejo was a member of the CNMV's staff from its inception in the late eighties until his untimely passing in January 2017. He was an economist by trade and the Head of the CNMV Institutions Authorisation and Registration Department for 15 years.

The prize may be awarded to any article, report or journalistic creation published in the Spanish media or in any format or channel between 1 January and 31 December of this year, in any of Spain's official languages. The deadline to submit applications is 15 January 2026.

Those professionals who wish to classify for the award may submit their work to comunicacion@cnmv.es.

The criteria for granting the award will be the rigour and technical quality of the work, the extent to which it promotes transparency in the securities markets and the protection of investor interests, as well as the contribution of the work to financial education and citizen protection.





The jury will be made up of three to five people and will be chaired by a CNMV board member. The remaining members will be individuals linked to institutions or associations related to the financial sector, including consumer or investor associations, or renowned experts.

The works will be chosen by the CNMV Communications Department, on its own initiative or at the proposal of any person or entity, and the winner selection will be made public in the first quarter of 2026.

In the previous edition, the award was granted to the report titled "Normas sobre criptoactivos, se acabó la ley de la selva" (Crypto-asset regulations, no more law of the jungle), by Jordi Fábrega, broadcast on the programme "Hora 25 de los Negocios" on Cadena SER and on the <u>Ser Podcast</u> platform.

Numerous institutions related to the financial sector collaborate with the CNMV to promote the Antonio Moreno Award.
