



## “SALVADOS” WINS THE ANTONIO MORENO ESPEJO JOURNALISM AWARD FOR EXPOSÉ ON FINANCIAL SCAMS

The Jury of the 2025 Antonio Moreno Espejo Journalism Award has decided to grant this ninth edition of the award to the report titled [“This is a scam”](#) (*Esto es una estafa*), broadcast on the programme “**Salvados**” on **La Sexta**. The exposé addresses **the dangers of boiler rooms** and the phone scam industry.

The Jury highlighted that the winning entry provides fresh insights on financial scams and boiler rooms, featuring **authentic accounts and unique perspectives** on this practice. Besides the quality and accuracy of the report, the Jury praised how it presents **useful information for investors**—in an engaging way and with enlightening testimonies—to help them identify these scams and avoid falling victim to them.

The programme was also recognised for drawing attention to an issue that concerns the entire financial sector and can affect anyone.

A total of 131 journalistic works broadcast on 24 media outlets and channels had been submitted or preliminarily selected for this year’s competition.

The CNMV created this award in memory of Antonio Moreno Espejo, who was part of the institution from its founding in the late 1980s until his premature death in January 2017, when he served as Director of the Institution Authorisation and Registration Department. The award carries a cash prize of 15,000 euros and will be presented at a public ceremony soon.
