Following article 17 of Regulation (EU) 596/2014 on Market Abuse, articles 227 and 228 of the Royal Legislative Decree Law 4/2015, dated October 23, approving the consolidated text of the Securities Market Law and other applicable legislation, and pursuant to the disclosure of other relevant information dated June 17, 2025 (registration number 35311) CIE Automotive, S.A. (hereinafter, the 'Company') releases the completion, on the date hereof, and once the relevant conditions precedent have been fulfilled, of the acquisition, through its Brazilian subsidiary Autometal Ltda, 100% of the share capital of the Brazilian company Weidplas Brazil Indústria e Comércio De Plásticos Ltda ('Techniplas Brazil'), a Brazilian subsidiary of the Techniplas group, now redenominated as CIE Autometal Piracicaba Ltda.

CIE AUTOMOTIVE COMPLETES THE ACQUISITION OF THE BRAZILIAN COMPANY TECHNIPLAS

The integrated company specialises in the manufacture of plastic components and supplies leading OEMs

Bilbao, 02.09.2025 - CIE Automotive announced today that, after the transaction has been cleared by the Brazilian antitrust authorities, the acquisition of 100% of the share capital of Weidplas Brasil Indústria e Comércio De Plásticos, Ltda. - a Brazilian subsidiary of the Techniplas Group, renamed today as CIE Autometal Piracicaba Ltda.- has been completed.

The enterprise value of the transaction amounts to around EUR 65 million - equivalent to around 5 times the current year's EBITDA.

The price of the transaction has been paid in cash and by means of cash available.

With around 600 employees and sales in 2024 of approximately 50 million euros, Techniplas Brazil has a plant in Piracicaba, in the state of Sao Paulo, and specialises in the manufacture of highly complex plastic components, including decorative parts and functional components, integrating injection, bi-injection or dual injection, painting and assembly processes.

According to Jesús María Herrera, CEO of CIE Automotive, "The integration of Techniplas Brazil not only strengthens our historical relationship with European and American OEMs and our more recent relationship with major Asian OEMs in the country but also represents an important complement to our technology portfolio. And it is a project that also offers us the opportunity to grow significantly in the coming years thanks to projects already secured and investments in production capacity already made".

He continues: "With this acquisition, we strengthen our commitment to the Brazilian automotive market, where we continue to increase our market share and where we are a reference supplier thanks to our multi-technological and global character, which implies an unrivalled competitive advantage when quoting to our clients".
