

The Financial Education Plan opens enrolments for its new edition of the programme and the "Finance for All" School Competition

The Financial Education Plan, promoted by the Bank of Spain, the Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV), and the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry, is launching the fifteenth edition of the **Financial Education School Programme - Finance for All**, and has also published the rules for a new edition of the **Financial Education School Competition - Finance for All 2025-2026**.

The Programme offers educational resources to allow teachers and students in secondary and sixth-form schools, along with vocational training institutions across the country to develop financial skills in the classroom in an interdisciplinary manner. Over the course of the previous fourteen editions of the Programme, more than 8,000 teachers and 550,000 students have taken part in this initiative.

The aim of the programme is for students at participating schools to acquire the necessary skills to manage money effectively, thereby enabling them to achieve their financial and life goals. The programme also seeks to familiarise students with fundamental concepts such as saving, budgeting, responsible consumption, various financial products, payment methods, investment, and insurance products.

Revamped entirely in 2024, the programme covers more than 200 skills outlines in the [Financial Competence Framework for children and youth of the European Union for 2023](#), among others. These include topics such as digital finance, sustainability, citizenship, and entrepreneurial skills.

Enrolment in the programme provides access to downloadable materials and support resources designed to reinforce the skills being taught. The Financial Education School Programme - Finance for All is free, flexible, and can be delivered across different subjects and levels at the preferred pace. Throughout the course, all programme content will be available in Catalan, Basque, Galician, Valencian, and English.

The competition is a voluntary and complementary initiative aimed at students enrolled in the programme. Its objective is to encourage student participation in a national contest in which they can demonstrate the financial skills they have acquired.

The rules for the 2025-2026 Financial Education School Competition - Finance for All are now available on the Finance for All website. Following the success of the previous edition, the competition will once again include two categories: Cadet, for students in the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd years of ESO (Spanish Compulsory Secondary Education Studies); and Youth, for students in the 4th year of ESO, sixth form (Bachillerato), and Intermediate Vocational Training.

The enrolment period for both the Programme and the Competition will be open until 27 March 2026. To submit your application, please complete [this form](#).
