Pursuant to Article 227 of Act 6/2023 of 17th March on Securities Markets and Investment Services, Aena, S.M.E., S.A. (hereinafter, "**Aena**" or the "**Company**") hereby announces the following

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

In relation to the disclosure of Inside Information No. 2847 published by the Company on the website of the Spanish National Securities Market Commission ("CNMV") on 30th July 2025, the company announces that the National Commission on Markets and Competition has notified Aena and published its resolution on the supervision of airport charges to be applied in 2026, in which it resolves that, based on the supervision of the parameters of the formula for determining the Maximum Adjusted Revenue per Passenger ("IMAAJ") contained in Annex IX of Law 18/2014 and the content of DORA 2022-2026, the IMAAJ to be applied to the 2026 fees is €11.02 per passenger. This represents a charge variation of 67 cents compared to the 2025 charges, including COVID-19 and border control costs in the 2026 charges. Of this variation, 43 cents correspond to amounts not collected in 2024.
