



IZERTIS, S.A. (hereinafter, "Izertis" or the "Company"), pursuant to the provisions of Article 227 of Law 6/2023, of 17 March, on Securities Markets and Investment Services, and related provisions, hereby informs you of the following:

OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

IZERTIS has acquired 51% of the company ANZEN AEROSPACE ENGINEERING, S.L. (hereinafter, "ANZEN"). This acquisition was formalized last week in line with Izertis' inorganic growth strategy.

ANZEN is an international company specialized in critical systems engineering for the aerospace and defense sectors, with capabilities in certification, airworthiness, and cybersecurity applied to on-board systems. Founded in 2019 and with offices in Madrid (Spain), Lucerne (Switzerland), Munich (Germany) and Washington D.C. (USA), it currently has a team of more than 80 professionals. It operates in the defense, aerospace and security sector- 85% of its activity comes from international projects, with a presence in strategic programmes in Europe and the United States, with collaborations in projects linked to Boeing, Airbus and the European Space Agency. ANZEN is also the best-positioned Spanish company in the Financial Times 1000, the ranking of the fastest growing European companies in 2026 and which also includes Izertis. A ranking in which, in addition, ANZEN has been recognized as the first in the Aerospace and Defense sector among the European companies that have grown the most over the last three years, a recognition that reinforces its position as a specialist in critical systems engineering.

ANZEN has a high-growth year-on-year turnover, with a turnover in the 2025 financial year of 5.26 million euros and a forecast for the end of this financial year 2026 of close to 10 million euros, with a goal of achieving 30 million euros in turnover by 2030. The price of the transaction, consisting only of a fixed price, will be paid entirely in cash.

The acquisition of ANZEN reinforces IZERTIS' position in the DAS (Defense, Aerospace and Security) area, in an area of high technological specialization, linked to strategic programs, regulated environments and systems in which safety, reliability, certification and advanced engineering are critical factors.
