Siemens Gamesa Renewable Energy, S.A. (SGRE) has communicated to Moody's Investors Service its decision to terminate its credit rating agreement with effective date on August 30, 2021. Moody's Investors Service assigned a first time long term Issuer Rating to SGRE on May 6, 2019.

Therefore, the rating agencies with a SGRE-solicited credit rating will be Standard & Poor's (with current BBB issuer credit rating and Stable outlook) and Fitch Ratings (with current BBB-Long-Term Issuer Default rating and Stable outlook).
