



THE CNMV LAUNCHES ITS LARGEST EMPLOYMENT OFFER TO DATE WITH 81 OPENINGS TO TAKE ON NEW COMPETENCES

The National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) has opened the call for 81 new vacancies for technical and administrative staff, this being the CNMV's largest bid to date. The call for applications is divided into a general call for technical staff of the CNMV focused on the supervision of markets and entities and others for specialised areas: Internal and Digital Communication, Information Systems, Human Resources, Cybersecurity and Technological Risk Supervision, Service Management, Property and Environmental Sustainability.

The majority of positions to be filled will be dedicated to addressing the new competencies that the CNMV is already taking on, such as the entry into force of the European regulations on crypto-assets (MiCA), cybersecurity (DORA), or the new regulations on sustainability. This call for applications is part of the reinforcement process related to human resources that the CNMV has launched to guarantee the excellence levels currently required for the supervision and regulation of financial markets.

Applicants holding a bachelor's, architecture, engineering or graduate degree may submit their applications as technical staff. The selection process includes an initial competitive examination with four tests: multiple-choice, English, written exercise and oral exercise. The structure and requirements of the tests have been simplified in order to streamline their development. Candidates who pass the competitive examination stage will have their professional merits assessed in the tendering phase, but no previous professional experience is required.

The candidates selected in the general call for technician positions at the CNMV will join the Madrid and Barcelona offices. Additionally, six vacancies are reserved for people with disabilities.

Applicants must submit a request to participate at the CNMV's virtual office, in accordance with the instructions and using the forms established in the terms and conditions available on the [CNMV website](#). Applications may be submitted until 31 May.
