



JURY DESIGNATED FOR THE SECOND EDITION OF THE ANTONIO MORENO ESPEJO JOURNALISM PRIZE

10 December 2018

- Journalistic works may be submitted up to 31 December.
- The winner of the prize will receive 15,000 euros and it will be presented during the second half of January 2019

The Chairman of the Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) has appointed the members of the jury for the second edition of the Antonio Moreno Espejo Journalism Prize.

This award was created in 2017 by the CNMV Board as a tribute to and in memory of the former Director of the Entity Authorisation and Registration Department of the Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV), a position he held between 2002 and his untimely death in January 2017.

The prize, which is endowed with 15,000 euros, aims to reward journalistic works that have stood out for promoting the integrity and transparency of the securities market and the protection of investors' interests, as well as for their contribution to financial education, values which guide CNMV's activity and that this agency must promote.

Prizes may be awarded for works published or broadcast in any media in Spanish or in any of the co-official languages during 2018.

The members appointed to form the jury are:

Ángel Benito, a CNMV commissioner, who will act as chairman;
Elisa Ricón, General Director of Inverco (the Association of Collective Investment Schemes and Pension Funds);
Jorge Yzaguirre, Chairman of the Spanish Institute of Financial Analysts;
Isabel Giménez, General Director of the Financial and Stock Market Studies Foundation.

The Jury will evaluate the journalistic works received and will make a decision during the second week of January.
