



JAVIER HERNANDEZ LÓPEZ, NEW HEAD OF THE RESEARCH AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT

The Board of the Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) has appointed Javier Hernández López as the new Head of the Research and Statistics Department. Until now, he served as Deputy Head of Financial Analysis at the General Secretariat of the Treasury and International Financing within the Spanish Ministry for Economy, Trade and Business. In his former position, he monitored financial markets on a daily basis and was responsible for analysing financial policies in coordination with other Treasury departments, as well as for overseeing financial stability at both national (AMCESFI) and international levels (FSB, OECD, IMF).

The new Head, who will begin his duties on 1 June, previously served as an adviser in the office of the Secretary General of the Treasury and as a technical adviser in the Sub-Directorate-General for the Coordination of Public Issuers. He has also worked in the Directorate-General for Macroeconomic Analysis and in the Directorate-General for Economic Policy.

Javier Hernández graduated in Economics from the Autonomous University of Madrid and holds a Master's degree in Public Policy from the Harris School of Public Policy at the University of Chicago. He has been a member of the High Corps of Spanish State Economists and Trade Experts since 2012.

The Board has thanked Eudald Canadell for his service as Head of this Department over the past nine years and for his career at the CNMV.
