



THE CNMV IMPLEMENTS MEASURES TO ENSURE THE CONTINUITY OF ITS SERVICES AND THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTIES BY ITS PERSONNEL

The Spanish National Securities Market Commission (CNMV) has extended the measures that it has been adopting in the last few days in relation to the situation caused by Covid-19 and the decisions announced by the health authorities. The aim is to ensure the continuity of the services provided to financial stakeholders and markets, as well as to allow its employees to carry out their work according to the guidelines established by such authorities.

As of tomorrow, 11 March, approximately half of the staff of its headquarters and of the Barcelona Office will be working from home. One of the criteria used for determining the staff members that would be teleworking has been to double the teams for the activities considered particularly relevant for the functioning of the CNMV. The Vice-Chair and other members of the Executive Committee will also be teleworking.

For other personnel that may be affected by the closure of educational institutions in the Community of Madrid, as of tomorrow Wednesday, 11 March, there will be greater flexibility in working hours. The possibility of increasing the number of teleworkers is being considered according to the organisational and operational needs of the different units.

Trips and public events, as well as meetings of more than 10 people have been suspended or postponed. Likewise, any face-to-face meetings scheduled will instead be held using telematic means, where possible.

Hygienic measures have also been strengthened and risk-reduction behaviour has been recommended in accordance with the recommendations issued by the health authorities.

The different CNMV units are specifically monitoring and continuously assessing the impact of this issue on the financial markets and on the activity of issuers and investment firms. Likewise, the CNMV departments are responding to the enquiries submitted by the sector relating to various issues.
